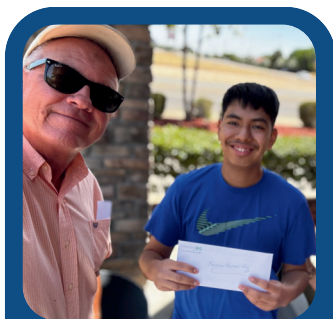

January to April

Visit schools, counselors, and migrant ed family meetings to publicize scholarship and post flyers at schools and businesses.

May 3rd

Scholarship Application closes at midnight.
Begin scoring scholarship applications & supporting documents.

May 12th

Scholarship Committee meets to conduct formal review, scoring and ranking applicants. Schedule student interviews.

May 14th to June 20th

Student Interviews & Presentation of Scholarship Checks

June 27th
